

August 5, 2013

Chairman Dennis Macheska called the regular meeting of the board of supervisors to order at 7PM on 2435 Hickory Lane. Also present was supervisor William (Bud) Brown and Secretary Sarah Griggs. Seventeen individuals signed the sign in sheet.

Bud Brown made a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as read. Dennis Macheska seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.

Officer Kreidler presented the police report for the month of July noting 124 hours for the month with 15 violations. There were no questions for the officer.

Being there was no public comment Dennis Macheska readdressed the agenda. The township received an email informing that Snake Road would be closed from 9:50 am to 10:50am on August 25 for the O'Malley Race. The Township received the inspection report, engineers report and 2nd quarter ground water monitoring report for Alliance Landfill noting no violations

Bud Brown made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Dennis Macheska seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.

Bud Brown made a motion to sign the winter maintenance agreement with PennDot. Dennis Macheska seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.

Dennis Macheska read the treasurers report for the month. The balance of the general fund was \$997,695.42 and liquid fuels balance was \$1,269,869.01. Recycling totaled 4.4 tons for the month of July. Augusts recycling dates were August 15 for Milwaukee and Ransom and August 16 for Mt Dewey.

Bud Brown presented the road report for the month advising that the crack sealing has begun and micro surfacing, seal coating and nova chip will begin shortly. Bud advised that Sid Michaels Kavulich's office has been contacted about the condition of snake road and the township will be meeting with T&D Power regarding the bonding of the roads. Bill Auriemma questioned as to what the winter maintenance agreement with PennDot is. Dennis Macheska advised that it is an agreement between PennDot and the township for snow removal on Ransom Road and Milwaukee Road. He advised that the township get reimbursed for the salt used on the two roads.

Dennis Macheska advised that the next regular township meeting will be Tuesday September 3.

Being there no further business Bud Brown made a motion to adjourn. Dennis Macheska seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.
