

February 2, 2015

Chairman Dennis Macheska called the regular meeting of the Ransom Township Board of Supervisors to order on February 2, 2015 at 7pm at the municipal building located at 2435 Hickory Lane. Also present was Supervisor David Bird and Secretary JoAnn Pane five (5) individuals signed the meeting sign in sheet.

Chairman Dennis Macheska introduced new Secretary, JoAnn Pane.

Dave Bird made a motion to accept the previous month's minutes as read. Dennis Macheska seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.

Officer Sigler of the South Abington Police presented the police report for the month. Officer Sigler advised that there were 9 incidents for the month of January. Suspicious person/activity was reported on Creek Road by a resident on two separate nights. Vandalism was reported at the 2000 block of Newton Ransom Blvd., specifically a truck leaving the road and continuing through a resident's yard then leaving. A threats call on Dark Region Road. Traffic stop near cemetery on Ransom Road, ending in a drug charge. Flim Flam or fishing investigation. Resident of 1800 Newton Ransom Blvd. had his credit card number used/stolen and used in Willow Grove, PA, this is an open case. Fraud on Creek Road between mother and daughter. Possible family sexual abuse, case forwarded to the District Attorney's office. A call of theft and an underage drinking citation on North Sekol Road.

There was no representative present from the Newton Ransom Fire Hall to present the report for the month.

Under Public comment: Malcolm MacGregor a resident of North Abington Township and candidate for Magistrate Judge introduced himself to members of the board and the resident's present for the meeting. He inquired as to how Ransom Township's experience has been with the magistrate's offices/community service, zoning issues etc.

Being there no further public comment Dennis Macheska returned to the agenda. Dennis advised that the township received an inspection report and engineers report noting no violations.

Dennis Macheska read the treasurers report for the month. The balance in the general fund was \$395,661.58 and the liquid fuels account balance was \$1,340,759.14. Dennis noted that the general fund account is a little low because the deposit that was sent in hasn't been recorded yet. Recycling for this month is February 20th.

Dave Bird presented the road report for the month. Dave asked how residents felt the recycling was working out and discussed keeping everyone up to date on the collection dates. He discussed that we are continuing to keep the roads clean and we are getting numbers for redoing Sekol.

Dennis Macheska advised that the next township meeting will be March 2, 2015.

Dave Bird made a motion to adjourn. Dennis Macheska seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.
