

June 6, 2016

Chairman Dennis Macheska called the regular meeting of supervisor's to order on June 6, 2016 at 6:01 PM at 1101 Community Drive with the pledge of allegiance. A quorum of members was present, also present was Secretary JoAnn Pane and Solicitor Ed Scacchitti. Nine (9) individuals signed the sign in sheet.

JoAnn Pane read the previous month's meeting minutes Jerry Brown made a motion to accept the minutes as read. David Bird seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.

Officer Hank Zimmer of South Abington Police Department read the police report for the month of May noting 114.5 hours of service within Ransom Township.

Under the Solicitor's report, Attorney Ed Scacchitti noted his services to the township for the month of May

There was no public comment.

Dennis Macheska stated that we received the inspection and engineers report from Alliance Landfill noting no violations. We also received correspondence from Dietz-Gourley regarding Scranton Materials applying for a DEP air quality general plan approval and/or a general operating permit. Dennis also read the treasury report for the month with the general fund balance of \$467,563.56 and liquid fuels fund balance was \$1,487,265.52. Recycling for May totaled 4.3 tons and June's recycling date is the 24th. The Supervisor's then reviewed the planning commission recommendation letter for the Bartholme property. Dave Bird made a motion to accept the letter from the planning commission and approve the removal of the Form B waiver, Jerry Brown seconded, all yes 0 no

Jerry Brown updated resident's on the MS4 annual report and the timeline for possible exemption status.

Dave Bird gave an update on the award of the bid roadwork package for Chip Seal and Fog Seal on Rock and N. Sekol, it was noted that Vestal's cost was \$88,000.00, Suit-Kote was \$55,510.75 and AMS was \$79,426.42. Dave made a motion to award the roadwork to Suit-Kote, Dennis seconded, all yes 0 no. Dave then gave the Spring clean-up results of 8 dumpsters at the Twp building, 3 in Mt. Dewey. 2.52 tons of t.v.'s were collected Dave also noted the possibility of not being able to accept electronics at the fall clean-up because of the \$1.00 per pound charge. Dave thanked Amy and Reilly Lewis for their clean-up efforts on Snake Road noting over 300 tires and hundreds of bags of garbage that were pulled out. Dave also noted the roadwork that will be done in conjunction with PennDot and the agility program, it was noted by Jerry Brown about the cost saving's to the Township by entering into this agreement.

Chief Jeff LaCoe from the Newton-Ransom Fire Department reported 11 fire calls, 2 assists and 9 EMS calls within Ransom Township. He also updated the resident's on several fires that occurred within the township.

Dennis Macheska advised that the next regular meeting would be July 11, 2016 in the Township Building.

Jerry Brown made a motion to adjourn. Dave Bird seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.
