Chairman Dennis Macheska called the regular meeting of supervisor's to order on August 1, 2016 at 6:00 PM at 2435 Hickory Lane with the pledge of allegiance. A quorum of members was present, also present was Secretary JoAnn Pane and Solicitor Ed Scacchitti. Ten (10) individuals signed the sign in sheet.

JoAnn Pane read the previous month's meeting minutes Dave Bird made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Jerry Brown seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.

Officer Hank Zimmer of South Abington Police Department read the police report for the month of August noting 134.25 hours of service within Ransom Township. Officer Zimmer addressed the resident's to let them know that an email was sent within the department regarding the discarded beer cans as well as the bicyclists in the area.

Under the Solicitor's report, Attorney Ed Scacchitti noted no services.

Cody Stanko, EMS Captain addressed the residents regarding proposals for paid ambulance services within the townships of Newton and Ransom. Copies of said proposals were available for residents on the table.

Chief Jeff LaCoe from the Newton Ransom Fire Department reported an incomplete report and would furnish the information to the Township at a later date. He also commended the Township for their 90% compliance for property numbering signs.

Under public comment.

Lenay Blackwell of Bald Mountain Road asked the board if the security camera's had been placed within the township on problem roads.

Dennis Macheska stated that we received the inspection and engineers report from Alliance Landfill noting no violations. He also read the treasury report for the month with the general fund balance of \$435,995.10 and liquid fuels fund balance was \$1,448,224.45. Recycling for August totaled 4.79 tons and September's recycling date is the 23rd. Dennis also indicated that the Township met with Liz Donato to review and update ordinances, Jerry Brown indicated that we budgeted money in last year's budget for the update

Dave Bird advised the residents about the upcoming Fall Clean-up and indicated that we can no longer accept electronics because of the cost. The agility program in conjunction with PennDot's work on Ransom Road has been completed and we entered into a new contract for 2017 roadwork.

Dennis Macheska stated that the next regular meeting would be October 3, 2016 in the Mt. Dewey Community Hall.

Dave Bird made a motion to adjourn. Jerry Brown seconded the motion. All yes 0 no.
