Do you have Questions on Stormwater Management?

- What is it?
- Where does stormwater go?

Stormwater is water from any precipitation (rain, melting snow etc.) that flows across the ground and pavement along with anything it has picked up on the way (soil sediment, oil, chemicals etc.). This water seeps into the ground or drains into storm sewers (the grated drains in the street) and through a series of pipes and roadside ditches, it eventually flows to a low point or creek.
