**What do grass clippings, leaves,  
firewood, branches, & stones have  
to do with storm water  
management?**

When storing any of the above, keep them at least 10 feet away from creeks, flowing water, or where rain usually pools after a storm. Water velocity in a severe storm can actually move stones as well as other debris. The water carries it to the storm sewer system where it has the potential of clogging storm drains and causing flooding.
